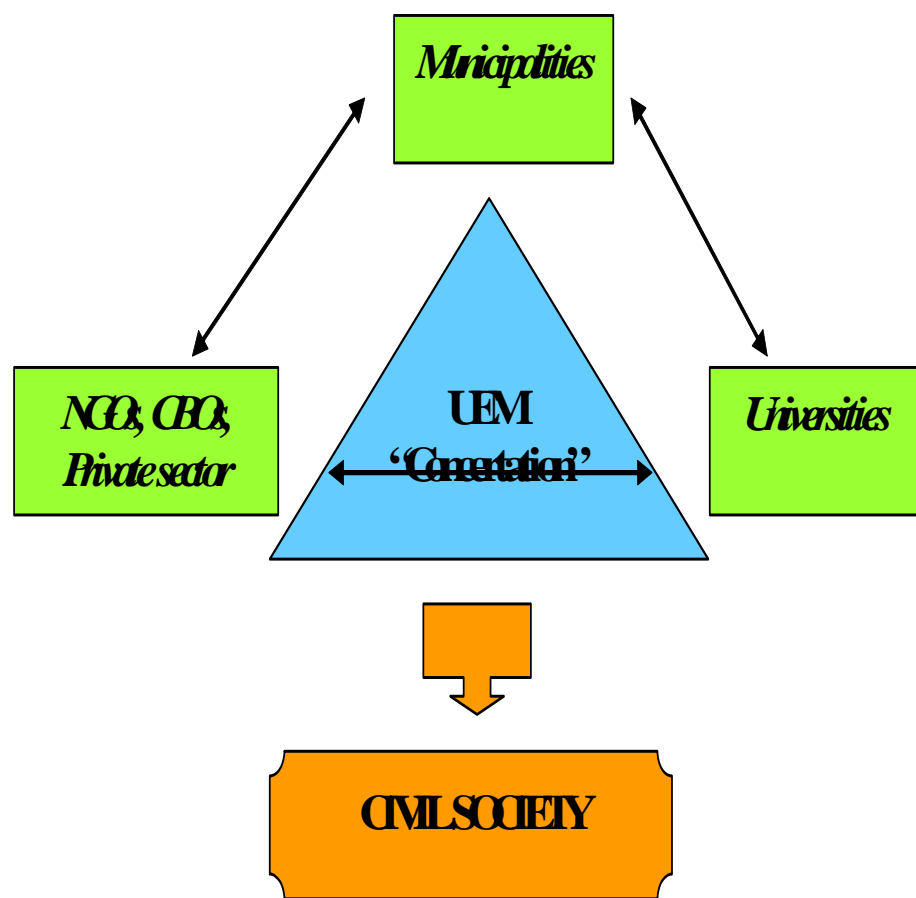

## 10 Years Building Environmental Management Capacities

The Cities for Life Forum is a national network of 86 public private institutions (universities, municipalities, organizations and NGOs), which promote Sustainable Human Development in 30 Peruvian cities since 1996. Our actions are based on strategic alliances between different actors in each city and national wide:

We have achieved in implementing Agenda 21 in 15 cities, increasing environmental investments with participatory budgeting. We have contributed to 5 Laws, 2 Ministerial Decrees and 10 Municipal Ordinances approval, to sensitize 8,071 participants on 81 events in 18 cities, to the graduation of 122 masters, 318 postgraduates and 3 PHD's.
