LEAS depends on partnerships:

- Union health and safety committees and activists
Toxins in the workplace workshops / why exposure to toxins affects health/ environment / workers right-to-know about exposure and to substitute toxic chemicals on their worksites.
- Joint employer/employee committees
Inventories and toxin elimination programs on worksites
- Prevent-cancer health and citizen activist groups and unions
Prevent cancer forums/ environmental exposure to carcinogens and reproductive toxins / CancerSmart Consumer guide
- Environmental organizations
Western Canada Wilderness Committee, Reach for Unbleached etc / their issues to union members and workplace issues to them
