# PROPOSAL FOR BY-LAW AMENDMENT

### **BY-LAW SECTION TO BE AMENDED: 6.01 f), g) and h)**

6.01 Composition and Selection

The National Council shall be composed of:

f) Additional francophone representatives, if needed to bring Francophone representation on the National Council up to a minimum of four (4); these individuals shall be elected by the National Council from among the member groups of the CEN upon consideration of a recommendation from the Nominations Committee.

g) Additional Aboriginal representatives, if needed to bring Aboriginal representation on the National Council up to a minimum of four (4); these individuals shall be elected by the National Council from among the member groups of the CEN upon consideration of a recommendation from the Nominations Committee.

h) Additional Youth representatives, if needed to bring Youth representation on the National Council up to a minimum of four (4); these individuals shall be elected by the National Council from among the member groups of the CEN upon consideration of a recommendation from the Nominations Committee

### **PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

6.01. f), g) and h) - Change the word "representative" in these three sub-sections to the shorter and more accurate term "*delegate*".

### **ISSUE ADDRESSED:**

This will help avoid the confusion that arises around exactly whom they "represent".
